
# **Garbage Collection Schedule for FY2023**

# Please take out garbage only in city-designated bags at the designated collection point by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.







- Trees and branches should be within 5 cm in diameter and 1 m in length, and let them dry for disposal. For bigger sizes than above, please contact the Cleaning
- Drain any fluids from food waste.
- If metal is attached and cannot be removed, dispose of on a non-combustible garbage day.
- For clothing and leather goods, take them out at "Irui/Kawarui kaishu box".
- For used paper (including "Zatsu-gami"), take them out at a waste collection site or at "koshi kaishu station"

# ■Dry Batteries (alkali/manganese)

Put them in the dry battery box at the garbage collection point.

■Rechargeable Batteries, Coin Batteries, Automotive Batteries cannot be collected. Please remove them from the main unit and take them to a Recycle Partner Store. XIt may ignite and cause a fire in a garbage truck or at the Cleaning Center, Please

never take them out at garbage collection points

# What is "zatsu-gami"?

· Paper other than newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and cartons Ex: envelopes, notepads, delivery slips,

receipts, empty boxes of plastic wrap All items with are eligible.

# Not acceptable for "zatsu-gami"

· Greasy paper, used tissues, food-stained paper, gum-wrapped paper, smelly paper \*These papers should be disposed of on a combustible garbage day.

# How to dispose of "zastu-gami"?

Polyethylene

- · Put them together in a cardboard box, a paper bag or a plastic bag.
- · Take them out at a waste collection site run by your community or school's PTA or at "koshi kaishu
- Paper cups and ice cream cups should be washed and dried before taking them out.

\*How to dispose items varies by community. so please follow your community's rules

# Let's try the 3-KIRIs for reducing combustible garbage!!

### Tsukai-KIRI (use up) Use up all the food in the refrigerator. The 3rd Sunday of every month is "Refrigerator Cleanup Day".

On this day, be proactive in cooking with what you have in your refrigerator. (It helps to reduce the amount of expired food.)

# Tabe-KIRI (eat up) Eat up all the party food served.

Please try the "Fujinomiya 3010 Campaign"; each person takes a seat and enjoys the meal for 30 minutes at the beginning of the party and 10 minutes at the end. (It helps to reduce the amount of leftovers.)

Mizu-KIRI (drain) Drain any fluids from food waste before disposing. It is said that 80% of food waste is fluid. Before throw it away, please drain any fluids. (It makes the garbage bag lighter and prevents bad smells.)

# **Garbage that cannot** Garbage that cannot be collected (Industrial Wastes)

# Large amount of garbage

cleaning, etc., cannot be collected. Contact the Cleaning Center in advance to confirm the designated drop-off date before carrying them (free of charge) or ask a general waste disposal company licensed by the city to dispose of them (fee charged)

Garbage in large amounts at one time, such as when moving or


Home appliances subject to the "Home Appliance Recycling Law (Kaden Risaikuru-ho)"

**Unsorted Garbage** 

TVs, Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, Freezers, Washing Machines, and Clothes Dryers cannot be collected. (Disassembled parts as well)

A recycling fee will be charged for disposal.
