

Please put garbage in city-designated bags and take them out to the designated collection point by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.

Plastic Products

Every Tuesday

Dispose of item that meet all of the following conditions:

1. Made entirely of plastic

2. Clean

3. Within 50 cm

Styrofoam, Cushioning material

Cup noodles cups

Bags of snacks

Food trays, Bento containers

Detergent bottles

PET bottle caps & labels

- For items with stains, such as oil, wash to remove stains, and dry.

- Remove price tag stickers as much as possible.

*If you cannot remove stickers, you can leave them in place.

①Remove caps and labels.

②Wash

③Crush

④Take them out.

Bottle caps and labels must be disposed of on a "Plastic Day".

- Only PET bottles marked with ♻️ can be disposed of.

- Water server bottles or PVC bottles must be disposed of on a "Plastic Day".

Cans

Eligibility

- Beverage cans (juice, beer, etc.)

- Canned food

- Milk, Candy cans

The following cans must be disposed of on a "Non-Combustible Garbage Day".

1. Cans exceeding 18 cm on any one side (excluding beverage cans)

2. Cans that are heavily soiled

Spray cans and gas canisters must be disposed of on a "Spray Cans Day".

Eligibility

- Spray cans (insecticide, hairdressing, paints)

- Gas canisters

No need to drill a hole

- Use up all the contents. *Guide: Please make sure you do not hear any noise when shaking cans.

- Heavily rusted cans must be disposed of on a "Non-Combustible Garbage day".

Glass Bottles

※Put them in the containers, with no plastic bags.

Clear

Lay bottles on their sides in the container up to 80% full.

Eligibility

- Seasoning bottles

- Cosmetic bottles

- Beverage bottles

- Medicine bottles

- Broken bottles and milky white bottles (please wrap in a paper or cloth to prevent danger) must be disposed of on a "Non-Combustible Garbage day".

- Do not dispose of lids on "Glass and Bottles Days".

Cartons

- Cartons (milk, sake, juice, etc.)

Kerosene Plastic Containers

1. Drain all kerosene.

2. Separate the kerosene tank from the main unit.

3. Place the tank upside down.

- Erase all data from computers and bring them to the Cleaning Center.

- Remove dry batteries, rechargeable batteries, and batteries.

- Wrap glass, ceramics, knives, etc. in a paper or cloth to prevent danger.

1. Remove the springs.

2. Separate into fabric, sponge, and springs.

3. Bring them to the Cleaning Center.

*If you cannot do so, ask a specialized company to dispose of them.

- Drain any liquid from food waste.
- Trees and branches must be within 5cm in diameter and 1m in length. Please dry them before disposal.
- If metal is attached to items and cannot be removed, please dispose of them on a "non-combustible garbage day".

Aluminum foil cups

Rubber

Small amount of trees & branches

How to dispose of grass from mowing

1. After drying, put them in the city designated bags.
2. Take out only **one bag** at a time.

Take used batteries to garbage collection points.

Used dry batteries and **coin-type batteries**:
Please put them into the dry battery collection boxes located at recycling collection points.
※For coin-type batteries, please cover them with tape to insulate before disposal.
Please take coin-type batteries to partner stores.

We collect lithium batteries.

Please bring rechargeable lithium batteries within 20cm to **City Hall** or **branch offices**.
※For bigger batteries, please take them to the Cleaning Center. Swollen batteries are only collected at **City Hall** and the **Cleaning Center**.

Reuse of Futons (Bedding)

The Cleaning Center collects futons (bedding) that are no longer needed. **Please take reusable futons directly to the Cleaning Center. *No need to tie them up***

Bedding items that can be reused

- Down Comforters,
- Duvets, Futons,
- Blankets,
- Towel Blankets

Bedding items that cannot be reused

- Futons with severe stains, smells, damage, or that are wet
- Pillows, Cushions,
- Zabuton cushions,
- Carpets and other floor coverings

From April, we will collect diatomaceous earth bathmats, etc.

Starting from April 2026, the Cleaning Center will collect diatomaceous earth bath mats and coasters that are no longer needed. Please put them in a city-designated bag, tie the bag tightly, and take it directly to the Cleaning Center.
If an item is broken, put it in two bags and tie them tightly.

Do not dispose of them at garbage collection points!

Garbage cannot be collected	Unsorted Garbage	A rule violation sticker will be put on the garbage bag. Please re-sort the garbage and dispose of it. If you do not know how to sort garbage, please contact the Life Environment Division.
	Large amount of garbage	A Large amount of garbage at one time, such as when moving or cleaning house, etc., cannot be collected. Please contact the Cleaning Center in advance to confirm the date for carrying garbage in, or ask a general waste disposal company licensed by the city to dispose of it.
	Garbage from business operations (Industrial Wastes)	Garbage from business operations cannot be collected. (Items used for the same purpose in the past cannot be collected.) Industrial Wastes cannot be disposed of at the Cleaning Center. Please contact a specialized contractor.
	Garbage cannot be disposed of	Concrete Rubble, Earth, Debris Waste oil, Paints, Pesticides Machinery parts Construction waste Carbon Dioxide cartridges Batteries Fire extinguisher Portable batteries Products using chlorofluorocarbons Agricultural machines *Hazardous and toxic materials cannot be collected.

* We may verify your address with your driver's license etc.
* You are not allowed to keep and bring other people's garbage to the center.

Closed for accepting garbage at the Cleaning Center

- Sundays (excluding the 3rd Sunday of each month)
- May 3 (Sun) - 6 (Wed)
- November 3 (Sun) - 5 (Thu)
- December 31 (Thu) - January 3 (Sun)

Garbage Collection Service Not Available

- May 3 (Sun) - 6 (Wed)
- November 3 (Tue) - 5 (Thu)
- January 1 (Fri) - 3 (Sun)

Plastic waste collection service will not be available on December 31 (Thu).
